Here is a summary of our efforts during the past year:

- **Summer Camp Success.** Starting within a week of the country shutting down in March, we began to assess possible mitigation measures and whether or not we could continue with our summer camp plans. Many of our parents wanted to know the same thing. After monitoring guidance from CDC guidelines, the PA Department of Health, the Bucks County Health Department and other resources, we figured it out. Our plan included dealing with air exchange and air treatment issues, taking temperatures, limiting enrollments based on the size of the classroom to ensure
